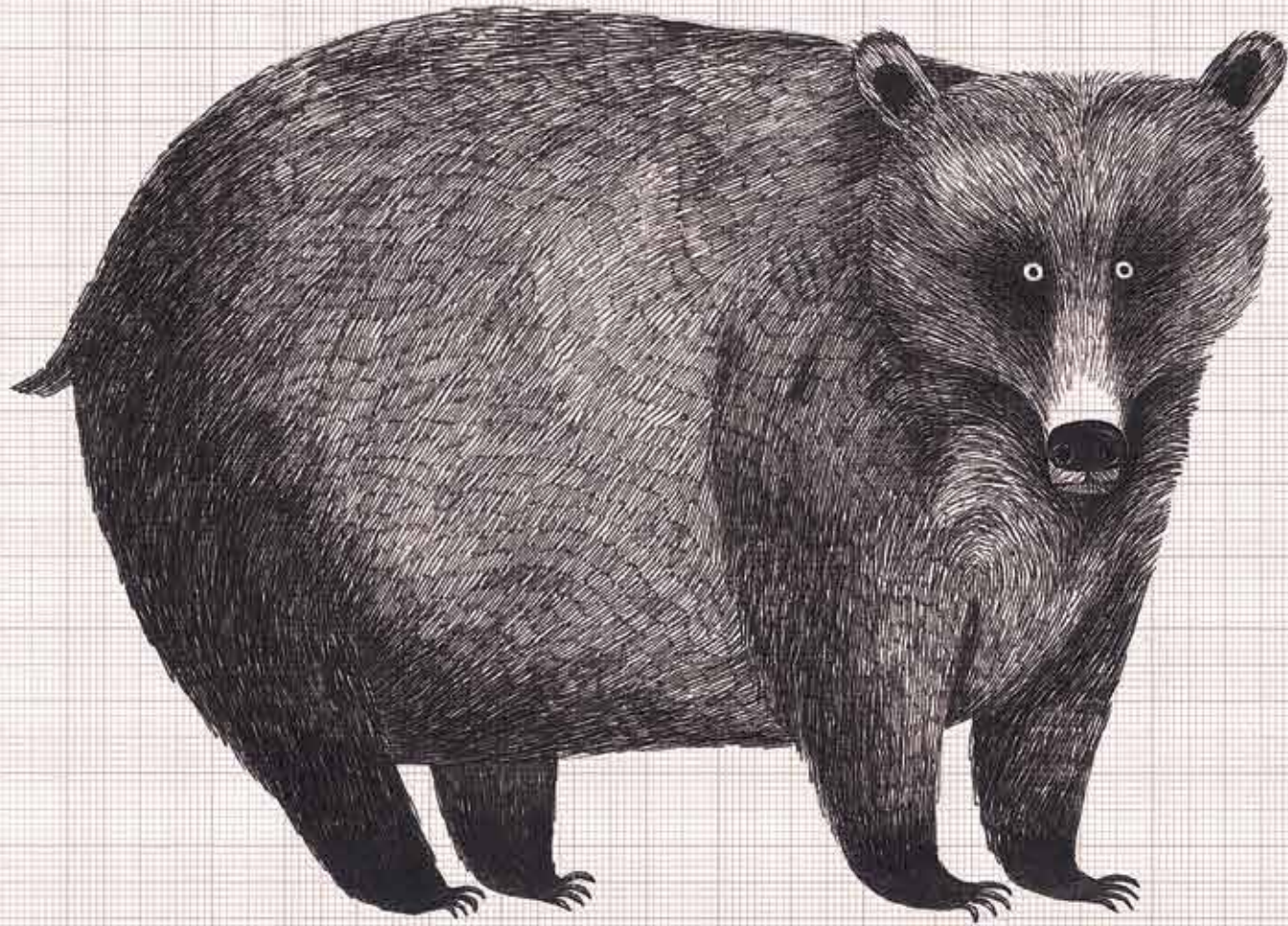


Going for

country?



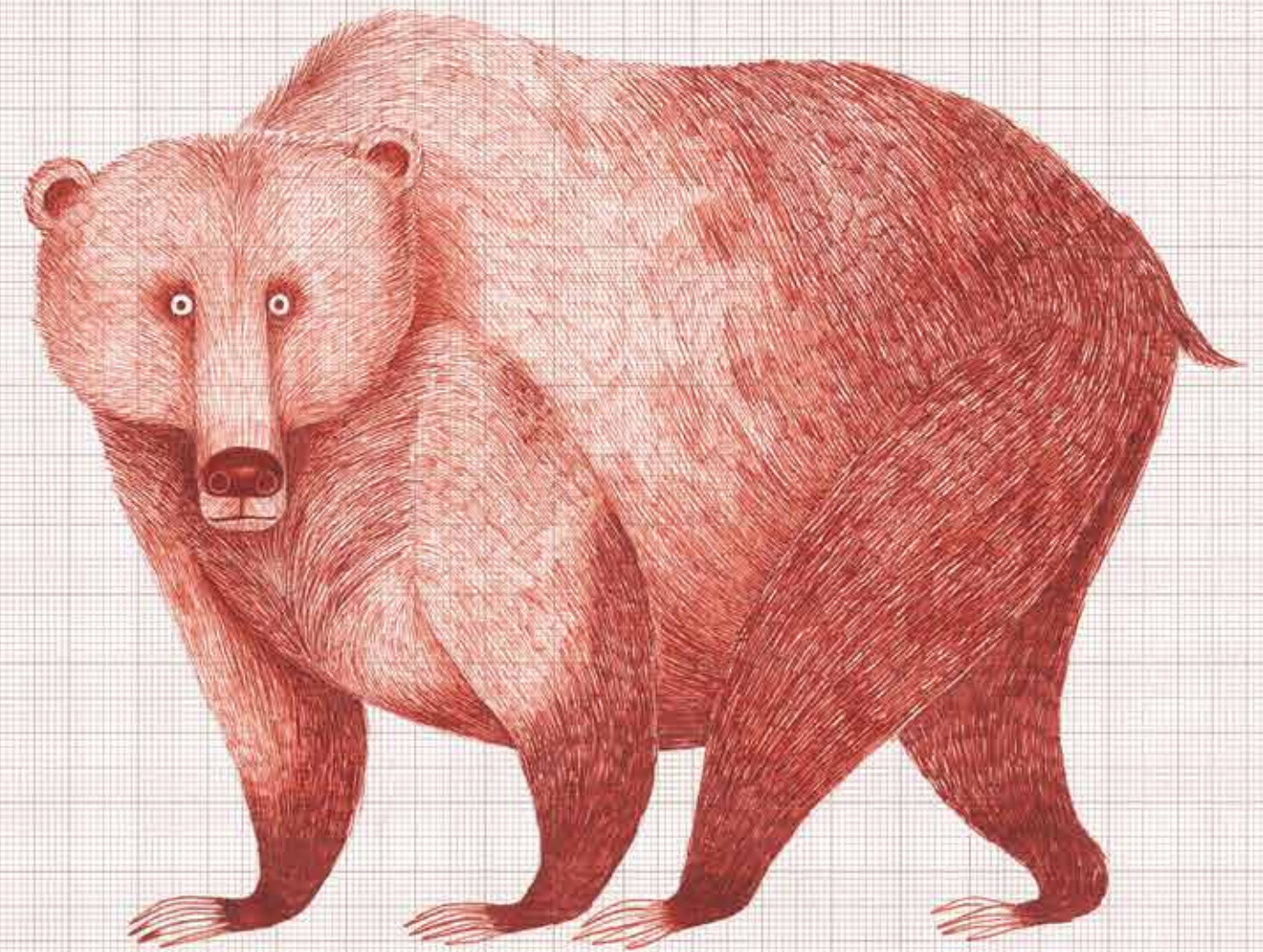
You'd better make sure you know your bears.
