Helping children read their way

World Book Day champions reading for fun,

because it seriously improves children's lives.

We know children are more likely to read if they think they'll enjoy it^{1.} So, we're here to challenge the idea that reading is hard work and boring. We make it fun for children to express themselves through reading.

Through our annual event in March, with its joy, celebration and fun, we encourage more children to read, and raise awareness of the difference reading makes to their lives.

Our 2024 research shows that children feel reading is something they *have to do*, rather than something they choose to do.

Read Your Way encourages everyone to let go of reading pressures and expectations, and empowers children and young people to have fun discovering reading on their own terms.

By working together to celebrate World Book Day, we can help share the joy of reading and books with more children and their families.

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World Book Day



While 70 per cent of parents and carers report that their two to four year olds 'love' or 'like' reading, this drops to 64 per cent for five to seven year olds (KS1).

Parents say that by the end of primary school, only 51 per cent of children 'love' or 'like' reading ².

At World Book Day, we believe there are six key principles of reading for pleasure, and these help shape our work. Children are more likely to love reading if:

Someone reads to them regularly

They find time to read

They have books at home and at school

They know a trusted person who can help them find the right books

We make reading fun for them

They are given a choice in what they read




