

Finally, they had all the colours of the rainbow!

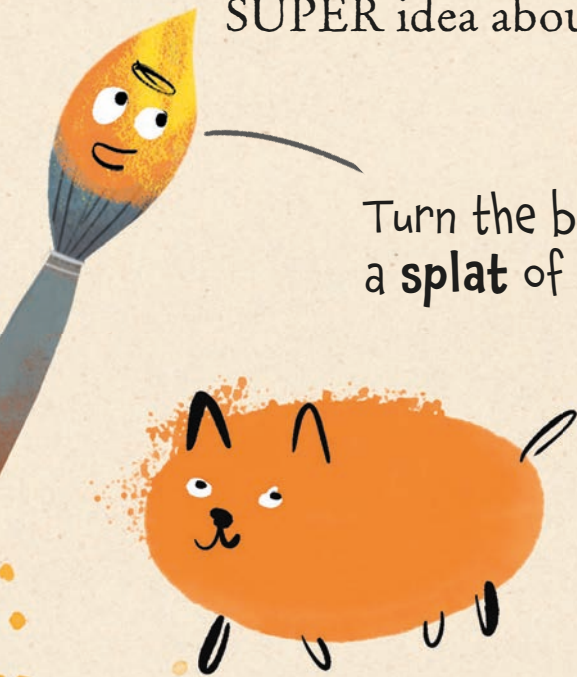
Oh no, it's getting messy again.

Turn the blobs into a splat of cats ...

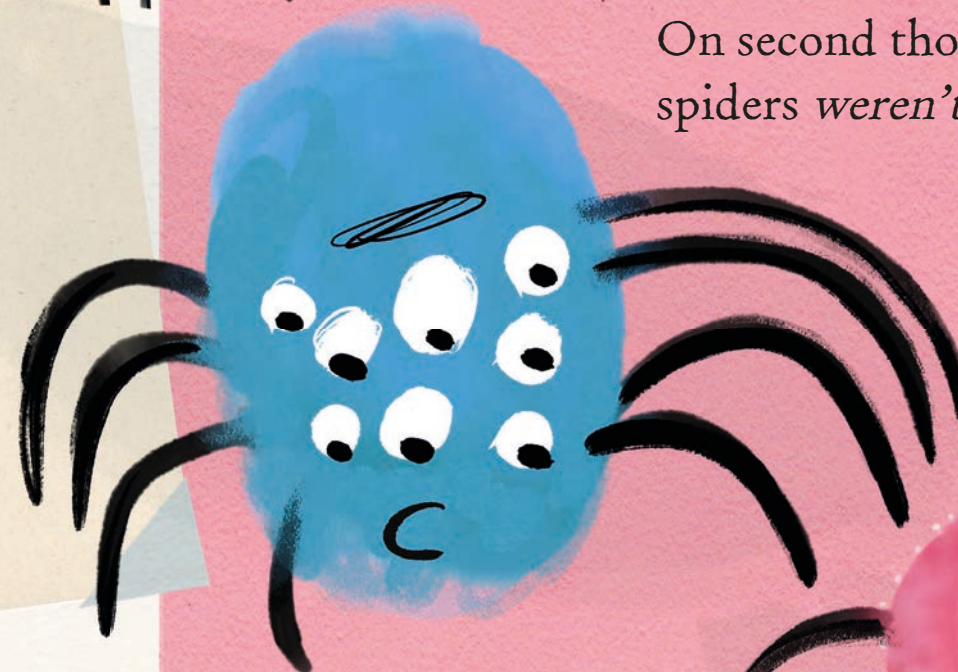


Then the boy had another.

Anything can be turned into something!

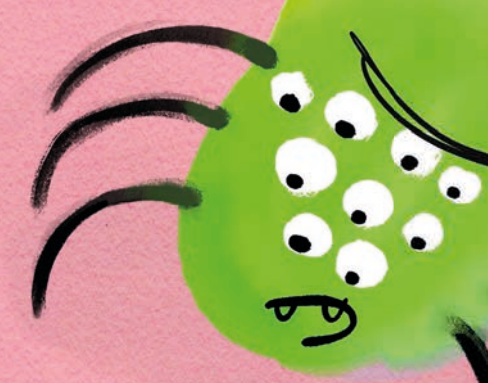


On second thoughts, maybe the spiders weren't such a good idea.

A Splat of Cats



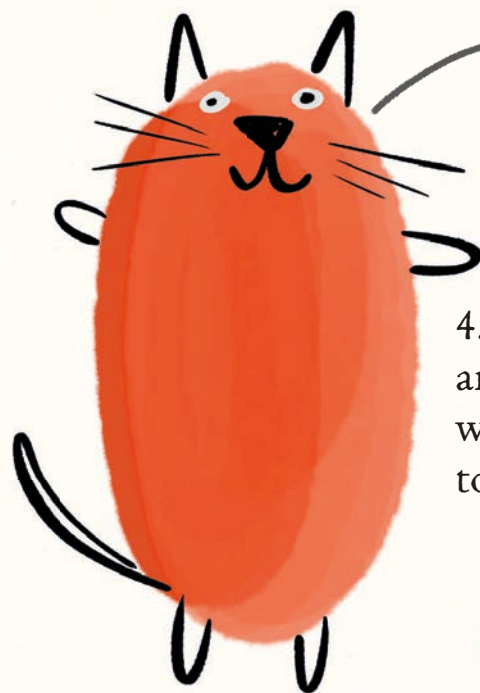
1. Paint a blob.



2. Add ears and a nose.



3. Add arms and legs.



4. Add whiskers and a tail. Use white then black to paint eyes. *Meow!*

A Dollop of Spiders



1. Paint a blob.



2. Add legs (spiders usually have eight).



3. Use white then black to paint eyes (spiders usually have eight of these too).



4. Scribble on some eyebrows.

5. Add a mouth—unlike the ones in the book, your spider can be friendly!
