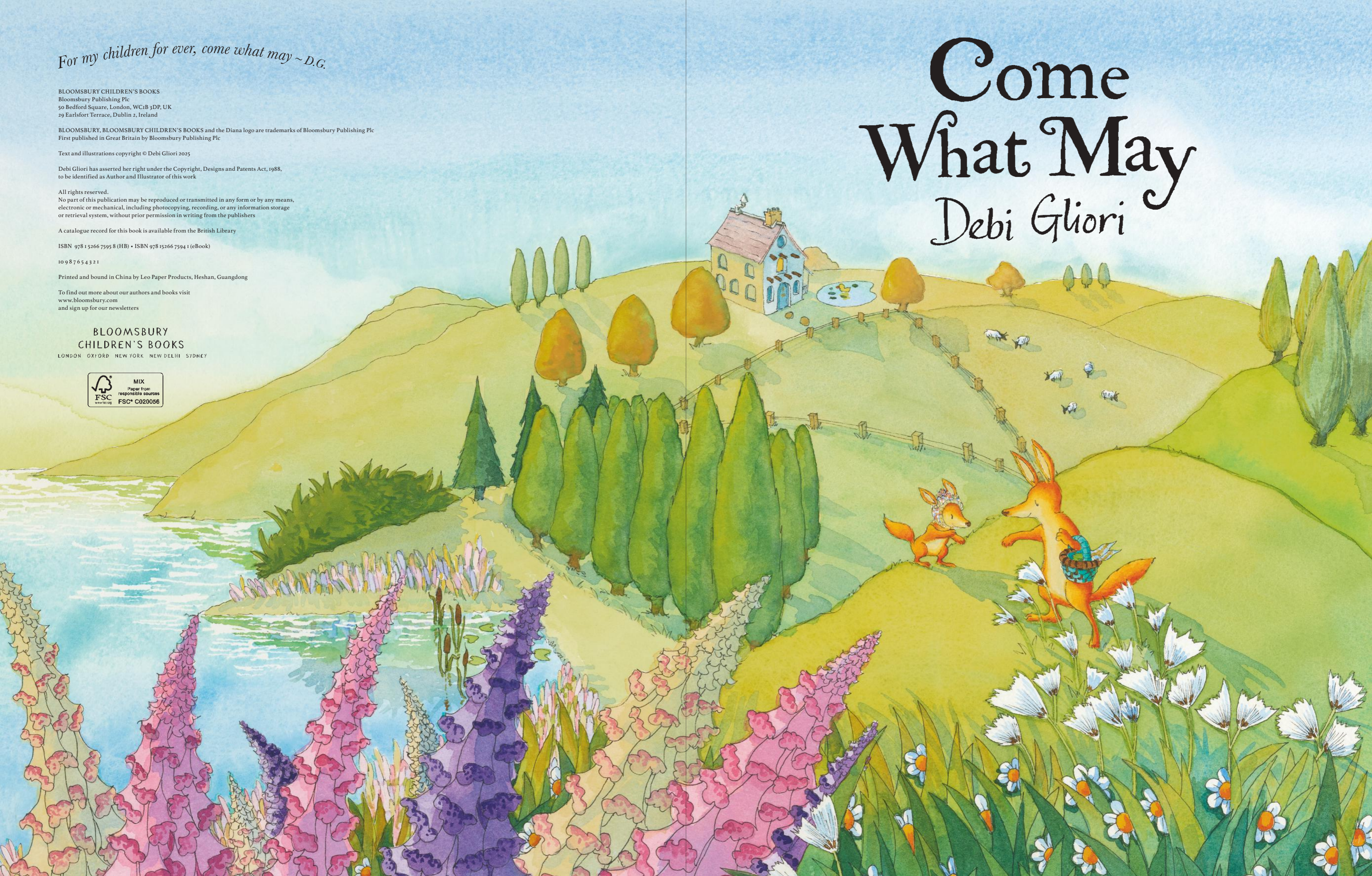

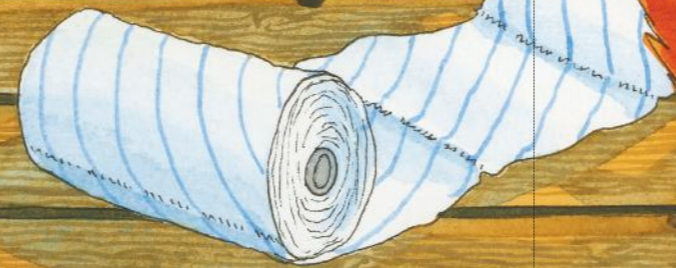


Come What May

and crack

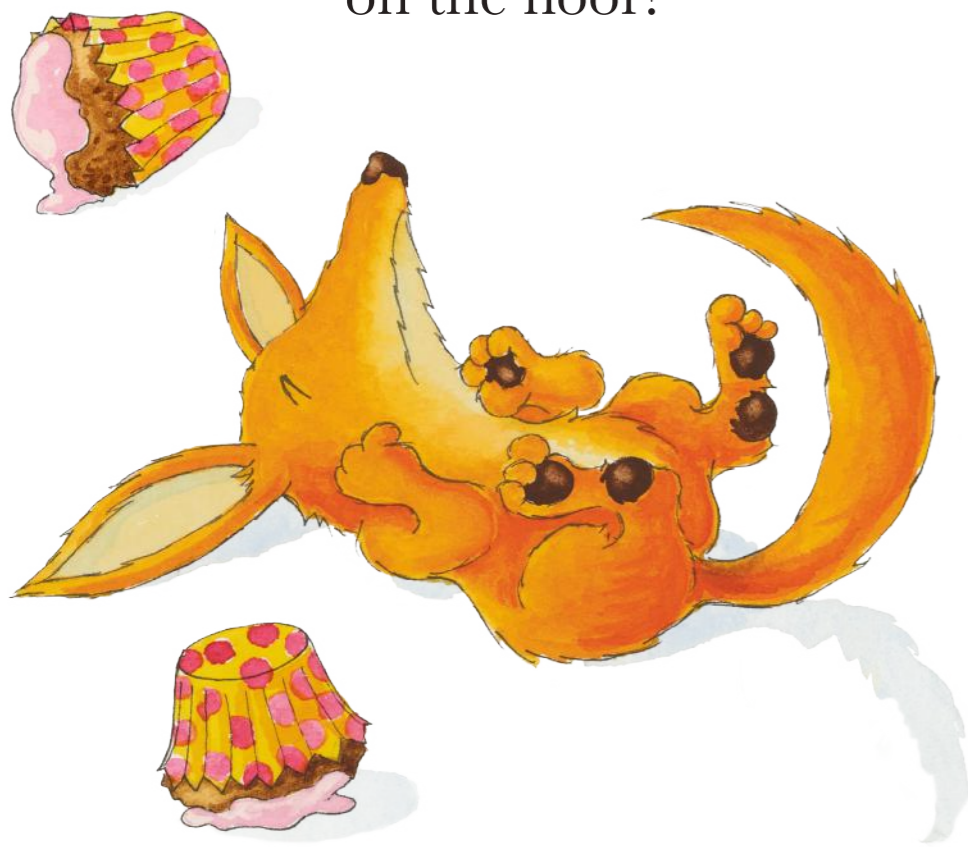
and bash
